PROGRAM

The International Technology Roadmap for Semiconductors (ITRS) has identified several candidates of emerging research device and circuit technologies. An overview of these emerging nanotechnologies will be presented, including resonant-tunneling diodes, single-electron transistors, and Quantum-Dot Cellular Automata, a concept developed at Notre Dame.

SPEAKER

PROFESSOR WOLFGANG POROD currently is Frank M. Freimann Professor of Electrical Engineering at the University of Notre Dame. He re-

ceived his Diplom (M.S.) and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Graz, Austria, in 1979 and 1981, respectively. After appointments as a postdoctoral fellow at Colorado State University and as a senior research analyst at Arizona State University, he joined the University of Notre Dame in 1986 as an Associate Professor. He now also serves as the Director of Notre Dame's Center for Nano Science and Technology. His research interests are in the area of nanoelectronics, with an emphasis on new circuit concepts for novel devices. He has authored some 300 publications and presentations.

He is a Fellow of the IEEE and he has served (2002-2003) as the Vice President for Publications on the IEEE Nanotechnology Council. He also has been appointed an Associate Editor for the new IEEE Transactions on Nanotechnology. He is a

Founding Member of the IEEE Circuits and Systems Society's Technical Committee on Nanoelectronics and Gigascale Systems.

February RRVS Meeting Recap

Michael Zolidis, Chief Engineer, Hamilton Sundstrand (HS), Electric Systems, and Director Electric Systems 787 Programs, gave a very enlightening presentation on Ram Air Turbine (RAT) Emergency Aircraft Power. Mike provided an entertaining discussion with the audience while conveying the history and development of the RAT at the world's largest supplier of this technology, HS. Mike included some excellent video clips showing the effect of RAT envelope design on ice formation on the tip of the RAT, as well as the effects of lightning strikes.

The RAT deploys in 1.8 seconds to provide emergency power. Since 1974 there have been 12 incidents where a RAT has been deployed, saving 1,421 lives.
