Program

Solar power is catching on fast. While it represents less than 1% of the current electricity supply, it is growing at about 40% per year. In this presentation, I will outline some of the pros and cons of solar power in Illinois. This will include a review of two solar projects recently completed in Urbana: the Solar Decathlon house (a.k.a. The Elementhouse) and the new system at my private residence. Some topics covered include overall viability of solar power in Illinois, performance, legal and administrative obstacles, rebates, and cost. The seminar will conclude with a look at some of the promising new technologies that may bring solar power to market even faster.

Speaker

Patrick Chapman (S '94, M



'00, SM '05) is Grainger Associate and Associate Professor at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Cham-

paign and a co-founder of SmartSpark Energy Systems, Inc. He received a Ph.D. from Purdue University in 2000, and the Bachelor's and Master's degrees in electrical engineering from the University of Missouri-Rolla in 1996 and 1997. He is a Senior Member of the IEEE, Associate Editor for IEEE Transactions on Power Electronics, and a Member-at-Large for the IEEE Power Electronics Adcom. He has received the National Science Foundation CAREER Award and the Office of Naval Research Young Investigator Award. He was named the Richard M. Bass Outstanding Young Power Electronics Engineer in 2006. His research in-

terests within power electronics include integrated design, electromechanics, automated modeling, hybrid energy systems, and energy harvesting.

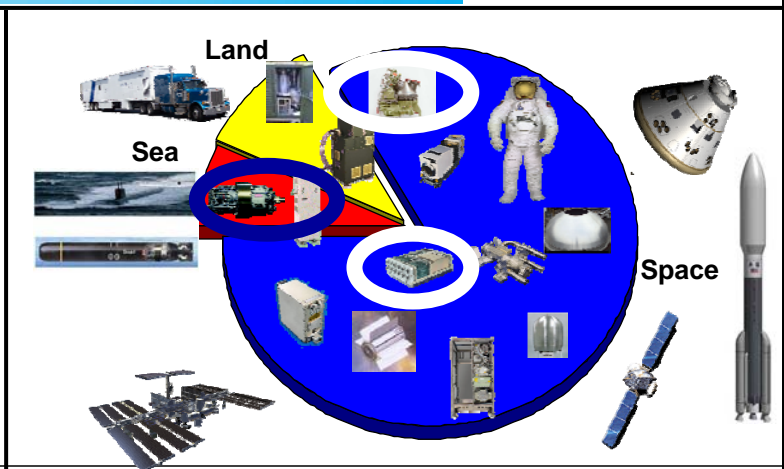
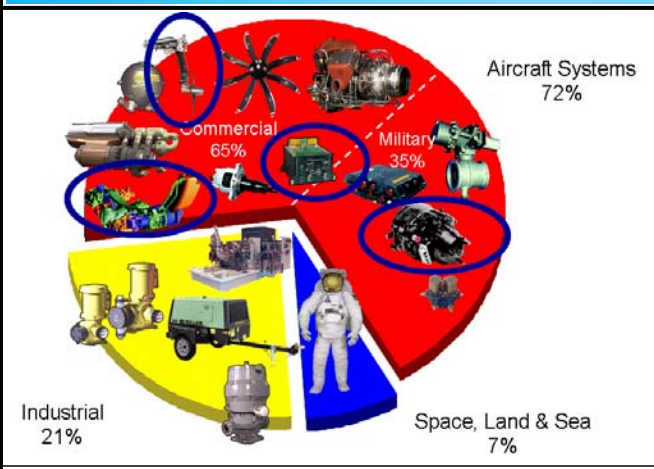
