PROGRAM

The focus of the presentation will be renewable energy and the work of the Illinois Renewable Energy Association. Their annual energy fair in August provides an indication of their broad approach to

renewable energy starting with energy efficiency. While technology will play an important role in developing a sustainable economy, lifestyle changes are also essential.

SPEAKERS

Bob and Sonia Vogl both earned PhDs in Resource Planning and Conservation from the University of Michigan. Bob was on the faculty of NIU for 35 years during which he taught alternative energy, environmental quality, leisure and research. Sonia was on NIU faculty for 22 years during which she taught field ecology, seasonal and prairie ecology, and interpretation. Bob and Sonia are founders and officers of the Friends of the Rock River, officers of the Illinois Renewable Energy Association, and advisors to the Prairie Preservation So-

ciety of Ogle County. They are also coordinators of the Illinois Renewable Energy Fair. They have presented programs on alternative energy and solar electricity in ten countries. They have installed a 3.6 kilowatt grid-connected photovoltaic system and 1kilowatt wind generator which provide 70% of their home electrical power; and have dedicated 35 acres of their 180 acre home farm to conservation programs.

Rock Valley College’s Engineering and Technology Division to Offer More Online and ‘Green’ Courses

In January 2009 the Electronic Engineering Technology Faculty and Associate Dean met to discuss the idea of offering ‘Green’ related topics in their A.A.S. degree. In addition the decision was made to offer as many hybrid courses as possible, in response to the Strategic Enrollment Management (SEM) Plan at Rock Valley College (RVC). The final report of the SEM Plan indicated a need for Rock Valley College to better serve students in their district by offering more online and hybrid courses and converting three day a week class meetings to two. This would save travel time and fuel costs for students, especially those at the far reaches of the district.

The Electronics Technicians Association (ETA) was so impressed by new RVC *Sustainability Emphasis in EET that that they are now using that Program Sequence as a national model. The ETA created a Level I Certification for an Alternative Energy Integrator based on RVC’s first year (full time sequence) of study. In addition, a Level II Certification will be available at the completion of the AAS degree. Since Rock Valley College’s Steve Fleeman is an examiner for the ETA, the students may take the Certification Exams at the RVC main campus. 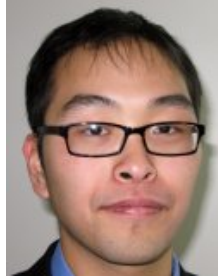
