### Program

With the proliferation of electronic systems throughout the modern world electronics engineers need to concern themselves with the prospect that the products they design do not create harmful interference to other operating systems. Further, properly designed products and subsystems of those products must not be susceptible to the unwanted or unpredictable electromagnetic environment that surrounds them. Many of us have witnessed "snow" on the TV caused by the operation of a "sparking" electric motor.

about citizen band or ham radio transmissions coming over a PA system? Other examples abound. The lack of electromagnetic compatibility may be , life threatening. This seminar focuses on a few concerns that should be noted prior to bringing a product to its intended user. With proper attention EM interference may be avoided through inherent system design. Precautions and fixes are discussed.

### Speaker

From the late 1960's Dr. Vincent McGinn has maintained a keen interest in electromagnetic effects on electronic equipment. In 1969 he entered active duty in the United States Air Force (USAF) after receiving the BE/MS degrees in electrical engineering from New York University. Within USAF he was responsible for resolving numerous Electromagnetic Compatibility (EMC) concerns at the NORAD Cheyenne Mountain Complex, US government navigation and radar installations as well as airborne systems which include the F-4C, B-52G/H, B-1, KC-135, F-16 and F-15. He became the EMC officer for the F-15 and additionally headed the avionics analysis of the captured MIG-25 Foxbat.

Dr. McGinn was a Senior Staff Scientist at Rockwell International

where he developed low observable materials and antennas for the F-117 and B-2 aircraft. He also pioneered swept frequency measurement techniques for radar cross sections (RCS).

From 1996 to present he serves as chairman of electrical engineering at Northern Illinois University. Dr. McGinn received his Ph.D. in 1985 from the Pennsylvania State University under Dr. Dale M. Grimes. Concurrently he discovered three new quasars.
